What is the Roanoke Valley Home Visiting Referral Center?

The Roanoke Valley Home Visiting Referral Center is a free service that matches parents, parents-to-be or others caring for young children with a free home visiting program that best benefits their needs.

Home Visiting is a service that helps new parents and parents-to-be get their children off to a

healthy start. "Home visitor" is a name used for a trained outreach worker, family specialist, or nurse who provides education, information and resources to families with young children. Home visiting happens in the convenience of

your home.



Roanoke Valley and surrounding area residents who are pregnant or caring for children under the age of 6 may qualify for home visiting services. Home visiting services may be helpful in the following situations:

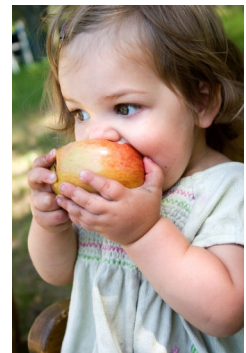
- A high risk pregnancy
- A child born prematurely or a child with special health or learning needs
- Several children born close in age
- Live in a group home for teens
- Care for young children as their grandparent or guardian
- Concerns about your child's development
- History of substance abuse or domestic violence
- Other situations that make parenting a challenge



How do I request Home Visiting?

Requesting services is completely voluntary and easy. Just take these steps:

- Ask your health care provider or case worker to tell you about home visiting
- Sign the completed referral form
- Your health care provider or case worker will fax the form to the Referral Center at (540) 982-2935. If you need further assistance, please call (540) 985-0131 ext. 503.
